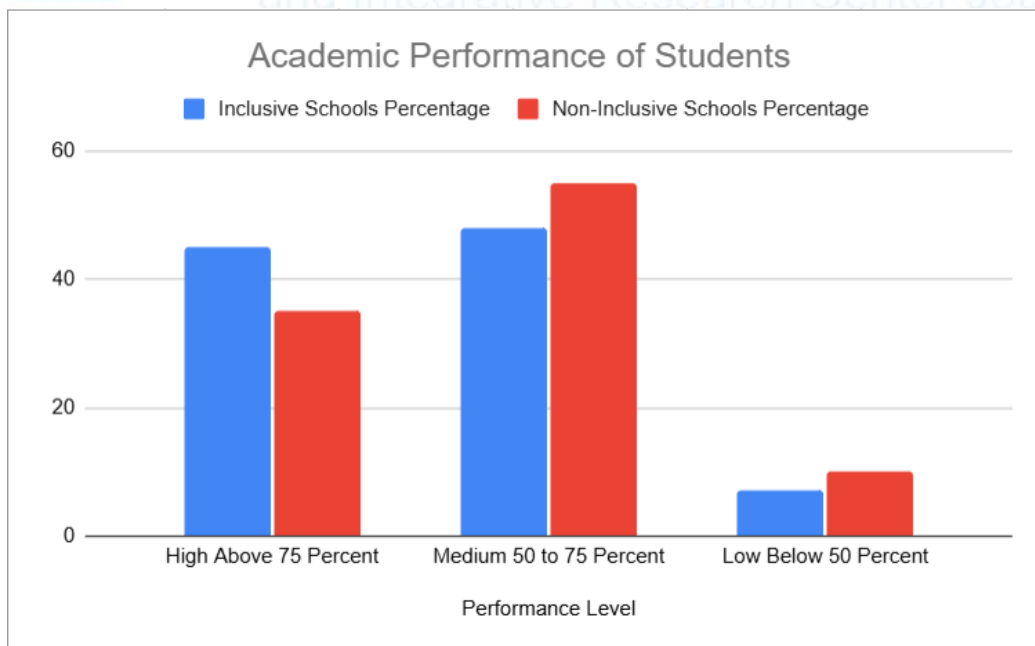

Figure 3: Social Integration Scores

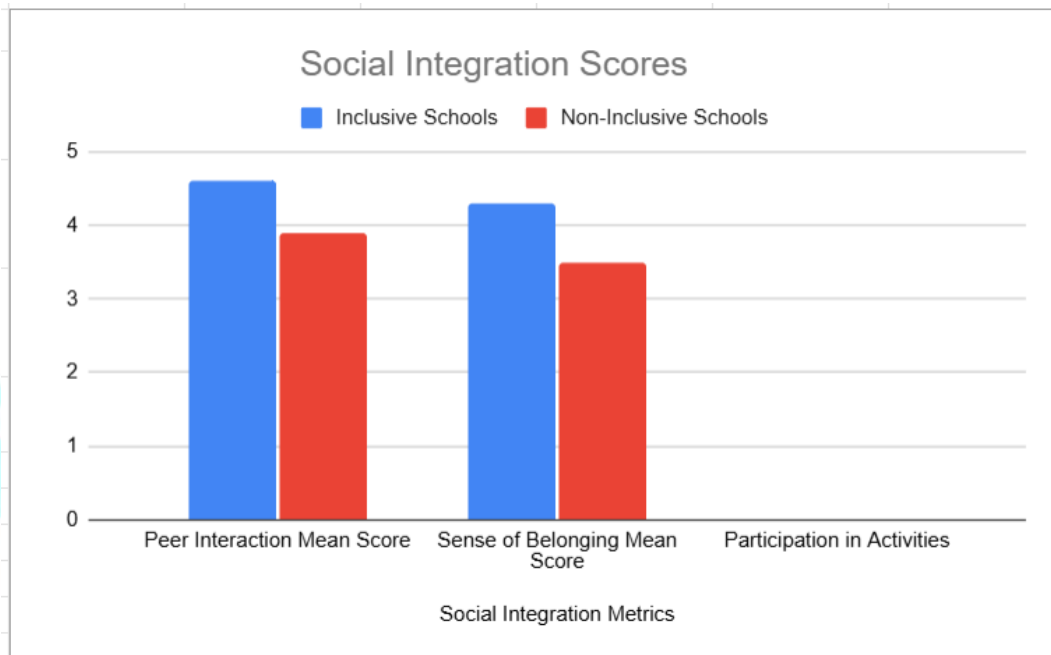
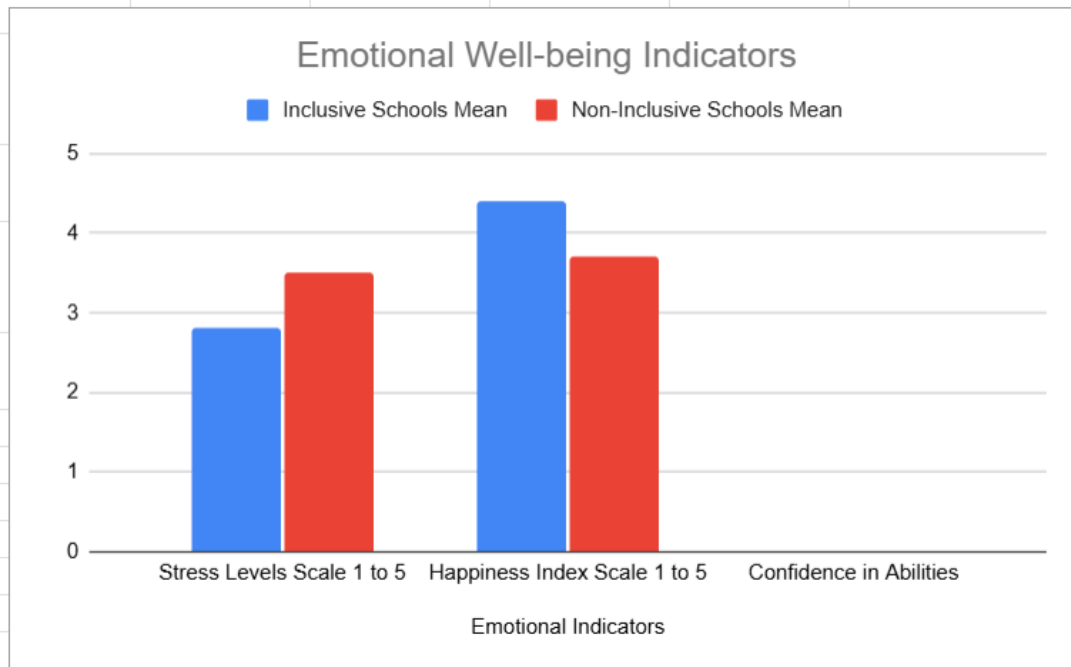
